What is aggregate information?

Aggregate information is used to show us the total number of visits to our web site and which part(s) of the site are used most. Aggregate information does not identify individuals, as it does not contain personal data. The information helps us to develop our web site and improve the service it provides to you.

Use and disclosure of personal information

Your information and personal data is not disclosed, sold or shared with any other organisations or persons outside The National Vegetable Society except where required by law.
